








## Troubleshooting Guide: ScanCast™ RI120078 with Verify on Receipt™

<p>I want/don't want to have the lot number for the product I scanned entered in the program</p>	<p>Scan the Lot Enabled/Disabled barcode to turn on/off the output of lot numbers respectively</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;"> <div style="text-align: center;">   Lot Enabled </div> <div style="text-align: center;">   Lot Disabled </div> </div>
<p>The ScanCast unit is not outputting into the program, and the lights are off</p>	<p>Plug the USB from the ScanCast into the computer running the program.</p>
<p>The ScanCast is not outputting into the program, and the lights are on with the amber LED flashing</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Check that the ScanCast cable chain is connected properly, refer to the setup guide.</li> <li>2. The unit may be waiting for the user to scan a specific barcode. When I scan an Item into the program I get an error that the item was not found	The item scanned did not match the reference in the database, the barcode must be added to the database to have the program recognize the product.
I scanned an item, but the item data was typed in somewhere outside of program, or it was not seen at all	<p>The cursor was not in the program's entry text box, click into this box, Scan Reset and try scanning again.</p> <div>  <span>Reset</span> </div>
